How to have <u>all</u> your sins forgiven and go to Heaven.

(If you want to...?!)

"I preached as never sure to preach again, and as a dying man to dying men."

No matter what you have been taught, know this, there is only one way you can get into Heaven, and that is through Jesus Christ and Him alone. Jesus saith... I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14v6. You can think and believe anything you like, but according to the Holy Scriptures, the 'Scripture of Truth' (Daniel 10v21), the King James Holy Bible, it is only through Jesus Christ, that you can have your sins forgiven.

There is nothing you can do to 'earn' or 'work' your way to Heaven. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: <u>Not of works</u>, lest any man should boast. Ephesians 2v8+9.

Being religious and going to church will not save you from Hell, nor gain you a place in Heaven. There is nothing that you can 'DO' yourself, to have all your sins forgiven and get yourself to Heaven, absolutely nothing.

Trying to be 'spiritual', or giving money to charities, will **not** get you to Heaven. **Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us**... Titus 3v5.

'Believing in a god' will **not** get you to Heaven! There are many people who profess to believe in many 'god's', rather than the one true God, therefore, they are not saved. **For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus**. 1 Timothy 2v5. It's only by putting your faith and trust in Jesus Christ that will save you, mere belief in a 'superior being' will **not**.

Your sins are what are keeping you out of Heaven! **But your iniquities have separated between you and your God**... Isaiah 59v2. You need your sins forgiven and taken away.

Sin is breaking God's Law in thought, word and deed. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. James 2v10. Take just the ten commandments, think how many times you have broken some of these.

You *need* your sins forgiven and taken away by Jesus Christ. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices (e.g. the Roman Catholic Mass), which can never take away sins: But this man (Jesus Christ), after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God. Hebrews 10v10-12.

As a sinner born into sin and a sinful world, you need your sins forgiven and washed clean away. And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. 1 Corinthians 6v11. It's only Jesus Christ who can wash our sins away, sanctify and justify us, you can't earn your salvation, or 'do it yourself'.

Jesus Christ left Heaven, became a man, lived a perfect sinless life, took our sins upon Himself, was punished on our behalf, ultimately by dying on a wooden cross, and went to Hell for us; providing a way of escape for all those who have put their faith and trust in His perfect sacrifice. That's it.

The Gospel is this – Jesus died, was buried, and three days later He arose from the dead ...**Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;** ... **he was buried, and** ...**he rose again the third day according to the scriptures**. 1 Corinthians 15v3+4. He is now seated back in Heaven with his Father.

Have you ever asked the Lord Jesus Christ to forgive your sins and save you from Hell? For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10v13.

Why not do it right now, just where you are... sitting, standing or lying down? Whether you are in your home, at work, or out and about, talk to the Lord right now, asking Him to forgive you.

It will be the best decision you ever make in life.

One day, very soon, we shall stand before God, either as our Saviour, or as our Judge. And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment. Hebrews 9v27.

On that day it will all depend upon what you did with Jesus Christ in your lifetime. In other words, did you receive Him as your Lord and Saviour, or did you reject Him, the consequence of which, now, you face Him as your Judge. By receiving Jesus Christ as your Saviour your name is written in the 'Book of Life'... And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. Revelation 20v15. Is your name in this book, or have you rejected Jesus Christ? If you have received the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour in this life, it means that every sin you've ever committed, is not only forgiven, but washed away by the precious blood of Christ. In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins. Colossians 1v14. ... the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from <u>all</u> sin. 1 John 1v7.

So, I'll ask you again, have you asked the Lord Jesus Christ to forgive you, and save you from your sins?

...behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. 2 Corinthians 6v2.

Religion cannot save you – only Jesus Christ can.

None of the following religions, organisations or cults, can save you... Roman Catholicism, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism, Taoism, Judaism, Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormonism, Seventh Day Adventists, Christadelphians, Unitarians etc. and none of them can get you to Heaven, only Jesus Christ can.

...the truth is in Jesus. Ephesians 4v21.

So now it's your choice ... what will you do?

I believe what Jesus Christ has done for me; I believe the Gospel I have just read. I have asked Jesus Christ to forgive me of all my sins and save me from Hell, believing that only the blood of Jesus can wash away all my sins. Today is the day of my salvation.
