It's been very hard but I'm so thankful to the Lord for all His love and support, and for all those who have stood with me. Like always, I get more than my fair share of 'nutters' and the start to 2023 didn't disappoint...! December was a tough month for JDA and January was average with February picking up. We've already had two trade shows and Lord willing we're back on track again. Loads of tracts, books and Bibles have been sent out worldwide and orders are coming in near daily for materials. Overall, 2022 was a great year for us in the ministry, at The Oaks Church, and for JDA. I am always thanking the Lord for each day of life and how He guides us through. I would also like to thank all of you who stand with us in the work we do, because as you know, we have many enemies, especially 'Christians' who attack us on a regular basis. 'Cast out'...

Satan is a cherub (Ezek 28v14), a created being (Ezek 28v13). He is the 5th cherub that is missing from Ezek 1v5. He represents the reptilian and aquatic animals before God's throne (Rev 4v6-7).

Ezek 28v16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. The phrase 'cast out' (John 12v31, Rev 12v9) is more than just a changing of location, it has to do with losing authority. Satan has FIVE' casting outs'... 1) Satan loses his authority in the 3rd Heaven (Ezek 28v16); 2) Satan loses his authority in the 2nd heaven (Luke 10v18); 3) Satan loses his authority in the 1st heaven (Eph 2v2) in the Tribulation (Rev 12v9); 4) Satan at the 2nd Advent loses his authority over the earth when he is cast down 'into the bottomless pit' (Rev 20v1-3); 5) Satan's final casting out is when he is cast into the Lake of Fire (Rev 20v10).

Dad and 'The End'...

From the moment I got saved I prayed that my family would get saved. My mum died an atheist I 'think' (I don't know for certain) and my sister I haven't heard from for over 30 years. My dad has been the most hardened atheist I've come up against. He hated talking anything spiritual or Christian. He was a nightmare to be honest, and his pride destroyed his own life sadly. Like my mother, I don't 'know' for certain how he died, but I fear the worst to be honest. I had numerous conversations and debates with him. I left tracts and Bibles around the house, and I wrote him a number of letters urging him to get saved and escape Hell and come to Heaven with me. Our relationship when I was a boy was excellent, but the moment I failed my exams and became a Christian, he turned against me in a very vitriolic manner. No one really understands what he was like, and I'm not going to explain it, as the Lord knows, Donna and Dee know, and Matt to a degree. I tried with him, but not hard enough sadly. I'm saddened by his death, but there is also a relief too in some ways. Other Christians also tried to witness to my dad, but always came off quite shocked by his angry and aggressive manner. Will I see him in Heaven... I doubt it sadly, but if I do, it will be a miracle and a last-minute death-bed conversion. The Lord Jesus knows, understands and always gets the glory.

'On his knees' – I've produced a booklet about it all...

And it was so, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven. 1 Kings 8v54.

On Thursday 12th January 2023 my dad died.

My Dad, who was 89 years old, was taken to hospital on the Monday afternoon, but discharged himself two days later as he was very agitated and uncomfortable being there; he just wanted to go home. I believe now, he knew he was dying and wanted to die at home rather than in hospital. I wonder what 'insight' you get in your final days and hours knowing that you only have a very short time left here on earth before passing into eternity?

Without going into all the details as to what happened during the week - to be honest it was very tough - I'll sum it up like this...



My wife Donna and I decided to stay over at Dad's house the night he came out of hospital, as he was very frightened; he actually said he was 'terrified', but didn't know what of. He was very anxious, in fact the word I would use to best describe what he was going through is 'tormented'.

My Dad was a hardened atheist and rejected God all his life. He lived in guilt, regret, disappointment, sadness, and fear for much of his life. My mother and sister had left him, and he also pushed me away too. He was a very difficult man, and wouldn't bend for anyone. Pride was his downfall.

My Dad and I had been estranged for over 25 years, so meeting him again, the day before he died, was a huge moment for me. Donna had looked after him for all these years, visiting him for 2-4 hours every day, and had really been a mediator between us. I looked after him from 'afar'. Most of you reading this won't actually understand what that means, and I'm not here to justify myself to anyone, God knows. It was a very sad situation.

When I walked into the room where Dad was, I saw a frail old man who was 89 years old, broken, and at the point of death. It hurt, and it hit me hard and deep. We spent hours sitting up with him, trying to talk to him. I told him I loved him at least four times, two of which 'penetrated', and hit home, as he looked at me with intensity.

He kept telling us that he was terrified, but didn't know why, or of what. He had no peace and was scared of the unknown, 'the future', as all atheists are, even though some of them try to cover it up. I urged him to call upon God to help him, save him, and give him peace. He responded with "Don't start...!"

Rather than even give God 'a try', he would rather suffer the torment and anguish of dying and entering eternity, not knowing that depending on 'how' he died, Heaven or Hell awaited him. He was 'hanging in the balance', and it was only his own freewill 'choice' that could decide his everlasting destination.

Over many years I had given Dad the Gospel, talked and debated with him, left him Gospel tracts, Bibles, books, written to him a number of times, and now he was at death's dark door... very much alone and scared. It was heart-breaking to watch, and I was going through many emotions... sadness, frustration, pity, sorrow, anger, helplessness, guilt, regret, plus a whole host of other things.

Donna and I stayed overnight, and in the morning, Donna received a call from him at 6.00am, so we both went down the stairs to see Dad, and help him in every way possible. We sat with him for two hours. Over the last few days, we'd had hardly any sleep, so when he was dozing off again, we went back upstairs to grab a couple more hours as Donna had said to him to just give her another call if he needed anything.

Donna awoke at 9.40am and went to check on him, and then called me immediately. I went down and we found him **on his knees** holding a chair. I placed my hand on his back and head and they were very cold, he had stopped 'gasping', and was perfectly still. The stillness and silence was surreal. His soul had departed from his body. The end had come. My Dad had died and now he was 'gone'. He'd slipped into eternity just an hour or so beforehand... but where had he gone, Heaven or Hell?

I cannot explain, or put into words, how the Lord sorted everything out over those final days. It was all a 'miracle' as to what happened, and there is no way I would have pictured myself reconciling with my dad in the last moments of his life, while trying yet again to 'save' him from going to Hell. I am so thankful to the Lord for helping my wife Donna and myself through all of this.

Donna is so much stronger than I with this kind of situation, and I leant on her so much that week. We are both grieving in different ways at present, and have had to push things back in our minds, as we're not ready to deal with them just yet.

I won't know until Heaven as to whether my dad got saved or not, the Lord knows. This man who had spent 89 years of life fighting and striving against God his Creator (Isaiah 45v9, Proverbs 13v15), finished up by **dying on his knees**... God gets all the glory no matter what man may think himself to be. Every atheist will fall on his knees and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord eventually (Philippians 2v5-11), whether in time or eternity. If he does it in this life, he'll get saved and go to Heaven. If he does it in eternity, he'll go to Hell afterwards (Matthew 21v44).

My feelings now after penning this booklet are... so much sorrow... 'If only', lots of guilt, 'I could have done more'... regret, sadness, failure, and loss. I wasn't the son my dad wanted, or could have been, and my dad wasn't the Dad I wanted, and could have been; we both made many mistakes.

We hardly ever agreed on anything. His atheism and humanism set us poles apart. When I became a Christian at the age of 18 it disappointed him and sadly destroyed our relationship, which would never recover. I'm just so thankful to the Lord that I had one last chance with him, and only the Lord knows how it ended.

For those of you who are in similar situations, my suggestions, advice, call it what you will, is this...

Swallow your pride and make the *first step* towards reconciliation. Don't let it go a moment longer. Don't do what I did and become estranged to your loved ones. Call, visit, email, or write a letter, but do something and try hard to put things right. Again, none of you will really understand my experience, but hopefully you can take something from all of this, for your own situation.

It's heart-breaking, but 'death is a part of life' as you all know. I feel very sad for my dad, and for what could and should have been, but wasn't. I know I can't go back... I can't try again... I can't talk to him anymore... he's gone, and he's left a void in my life.

When death comes, it really does 'sting'... it hurts, and it's crushing.

- 1 Corinthians 15v53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- 54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- 55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
- 56 The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.
- 57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

I thank God that soon, 'death' shall be no more. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. Revelation 21v4.

Learn to forgive and don't hold grudges. Don't let bitterness take hold of you, as this will destroy your life.

I hope to see my dad in Heaven... but I don't know... I just hope.

The question now is...

Do you know where you are going when you die? You can 'know'...!

- 1 John 5v11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
- 12 He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.
- 13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

You have a choice: to die 'in your sins' and take them to Hell with you... or... 'to die with your sins forgiven' and go to Heaven. We are all sinners, and Jesus Christ came to take all of our sins upon Himself, die, be judged in our place, go to Hell for us, and rise again the third day conquering sin and death. For all those who have put their faith and trust in what He did, in other words, **believed the Gospel** (the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ), we can have everlasting life and a place in Heaven. You either receive the Lord Jesus Christ as your Saviour, or you reject Him, that's your choice.

Here are some Scriptures from the Bible to help you understand more...

Romans 3v23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 5v12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

Acts 16v30+31 ...Sirs, what must I do to be saved? ...Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Colossians 1v14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

After reading these Scriptures, why don't you cry out to the Lord Jesus Christ asking Him to forgive all of your sins?

Romans 10v9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

- 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

I will carry this sad and true account of my dad's death with me until my own work on earth is done. I enjoyed my childhood, not knowing what was really going on 'behind the scenes', and what problems my parents were having together. As a child, life is full of fun, and *should* be. Your parents are your protectors, guardians, and people you can love, trust and turn to about anything, but sadly, for many, this is not the case.

I loved my dad. He was my 'hero' when I was a child, but as I got older and found my own path through life, we grew apart, as he didn't approve of my choices, and wouldn't accept me as a Christian.

Now he has left this world, and all I have is memories. As you are reading this, my dad is 'somewhere', Heaven or Hell, only the Lord knows, but one day I too shall find out. I hope it's Heaven.

Every day I think about him, but I have to stop myself from entering 'dark places' where my heart would just break, as I have many regrets. Like you, we all have to deal with 'life and death', and it's very hard at times. We don't want things to happen the way they do, but oftentimes we find ourselves in places because of the choices we've made, whether they be good or had.

I have chosen to walk with the Lord Jesus Christ, asking Him to guide me through life. It's the best decision I ever made, and would urge you to do the same.

The Lord said... I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. Hebrews 13v5.

For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death. Psalm 48v14.

'The beast that thou sawest was, and is not' – this is the Devil in a certain type of 'manifestation' as a MAN, the counterfeit of God manifest in the flesh as Jesus Christ was (Heb 10v5, 1 Tim 3v16, Isa 7v10-15).

Rev 17v10+11 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space. And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

The 'Beast' is Satan (the Dragon), but he also comes as a 'man', just like our Lord Jesus did.

This Sodomite picks and chooses which Scriptures are relevant for him...!





1 + 1 + 1 = 3 - 'NOT' THREE 'God's'



The Balanced Diet by Matt...

Since my conversion in September 2017, the Lord has taught me many things, and He's opened my eyes to many topics about which, prior to salvation, I had no idea about!

The Lord Jesus Christ. Who He is. What He is like. What He is like in character, and how He wants me to live.

The attributes of God.

The Bible. itself.

Sound doctrine.

Christian liberty and holiness.

The local church, what it is, and what it is not!

The Bible version issue.

Dispensational teaching.

Prophecy.

What God approves of, and what God condemns as sin.

The Christian is always learning.

The Christian life after you get saved is a massive journey, and I've had to learn many lessons the hard way, because of my own sin, pride, stubbornness and foolishness.

I've been saved now for 5 and a half years, as I'm writing this article. One of the things John mentioned when I first came to the Oaks church (one year after I got saved back in September 2018) was the thing of being a balanced Christian. This always stuck with me, because at the time, I never really understood what that meant.

In the years that followed, I'm learning now that a fruitful Christian life really is a matter of balance and correct prioritisation (majoring on the important things, and not making mountains out of molehills. Not making a massive deal out of peripheral issues!).

The Lord should come first, above all things. Others next, and yourself last. But we know, that the Bible is so much more than merely a religious book, of do's and don'ts. The Bible is the word of God, and it is God's revelation of Himself to us, in a book! How in the world can a book be written about God? Volumes and volumes and volumes of written material has been produced, about the most minute of topics! Chemistry, manufacturing, music and so on. And yet the Bible is what God has given to us, to learn about Him. Who we are, what we ought to be doing, and where we'll go after death.

It's very easy to become an unbalanced Christian. To be heavy on certain aspects of the Bible and doctrine, and neglectful of others. Many Christians get obsessive over certain topics and doctrines, and set themselves up as some sort of authority on the subject. We all ought to aim to be balanced as believers and we ought to be questioning our walk with the Lord and examining ourselves, all of the time.

Are you balanced in these areas?

Prophetic teaching – You'll meet and listen to Christians, who are massively into prophecy and prophetic teaching. It's great that they are looking for the Lord's return, and that is something that we all should do. You don't want to become watered down, in this regard. But oftentimes, Christians end up being obsessive over the news and current events (and now alternative news media sites like Rumble, Telegram and BitChute), to the neglect of practical Christian living. Over the reading of the word of God. Prayer. Bible study. Passing out tracts. Generosity and care for other believers. You don't want to get to a place where you are using the imminence of the rapture to sit around, looking at headlines all day, and you're doing nothing for the Lord with your life! A lot of Christians are unbalanced in this area, sadly. We thank God for the blessed hope of Titus 2:13, but until the Lord calls us home, there is still so much to do for Him!

I find studies on the rapture, the Tribulation (Daniel's 70th week or the Time of Jacob's trouble) and the Millennial reign of the Lord Jesus Christ, the New Jerusalem and eternity, to be as fascinating as anybody else. But some preachers and teachers spend their time on nothing else! When you're dealing with all of life's many ups and downs, times of sickness, financial struggles, bust ups with friends, family and other Christians, fears and worries, sin problems and when you're trying to help other believers with their burdens. If all you've been feeding on is prophecy, studies about what the earth was like before Genesis 1v2, angels and devils and future events, you'll find that you won't be prepared to deal with these practical situations! A Christian preacher or teacher ought to meet the needs of the people he is ministering to.

On the contrary, if you haven't got your prophetic view in line with the scriptures, you'll be easy pickings for false teachers and for the religious liberals. 90% of professing Christians believe that the world is getting better and better, and that they are actually involved in bringing in the Kingdom! They don't even know that the Lord is going to return, never mind all of these things that are pointing to the end of the current dispensation. The scamdemic, hyperinflation, and all of the rest of it. They're easy pickings, ripe to be fleeced by the likes of the prosperity preachers and every man and his dog out there with a charity begging bowl. The key is to be balanced. We're here to love and serve the Lord, to get the gospel out to the unsaved and to minister to the church, the body of Christ. We're not here to reform the government, to be social workers or to be environmentalists. We know that this world is going to be totally burned up, one day soon! (2 Peter 3:10).

Doctrine – You need to be built up in doctrine. We all do. Doctrine, really, is about what is right in the sight of God. When you've lived your whole life doing things contrary to what God approves of, you want to get your life sorted out and you want the Lord to clean you up, as you obey Him! And once you know what the Lord approves of and disapproves of, you

want to remain balanced. If you get too liberal and loose, you'll use eternal security to justify all types of sin and you'll end up being a powerless, worldly, compromised Christian. If you get too legalistic, you'll start getting into unnecessary problems. You'll find yourself being drawn into arguments that are pointless. I've met many, incredibly legalistic Christians during the time in which that I have been saved, and when all has been said and done, they've all been hypocrites in one way or another. The double-standards that these people come up with, truly beggars' belief! I've met legalistic Christians who won't listen to any music that is not "Christian", including classical music, but they'll happily watch hours of brainwashing secular TV in the evenings. I've met Christians who'll dress like the Amish and Mennonites, covering everything up and looking very holy, but they're bulldog bitter and spiteful, always moaning and complaining about one thing or another! A real drag to be around! I've listened to Christian preachers and teachers who'll shout and whack their pulpits, they'll rant and rave in their churches, but as soon as there's a bit of pressure, as soon as things like the lockdowns came about, they remained absolutely silent (They wouldn't want to risk losing their income!). On the same note, I've met Christians who are very vocal in church, shouting "Amen!" and whooping and all of the rest of it when they're sitting through a sermon, but everybody knows that they're living in sin and that their personal lives are a shambles. I've met Christians who'll preach on the streets and militantly pass out tracts, but they'll always make sure that they're being filmed as they're doing it! Is their motive to serve the Lord, or to become online celebrities? I've met Christians who are very well read, and concerning the Bible, they're incredibly knowledgeable about many deep topics, but when you deal with them, they're tighter than a submarine door with their money! You're always going to be picking up the bill when you go out with them! The Lord has standards, but you'd better make sure that you're not on the road to becoming a legalistic pharisee, majoring on certain doctrines but being a total hypocrite when it comes to others.

Christian devotional teaching – Sometimes you'll read the scriptures for comfort. We all ought to do that, throughout our Christian lives, and we're told about this in Romans 15:4. A good question to think about is this. Why are you reading the Bible? Some people read the Bible to acquire head knowledge. If they know every intricate detail about genealogy, biblical numerology and aspects of the covenants and dispensations, they can set themselves up as an authority on the subject and the whole thing becomes an ego trip. They can "draw away" disciples after themselves, and go off on an unbalanced tangent (Acts 20:30). One thing I've learned is that you're going to have to take the meat and leave the bones with many a Christian teacher, preacher and author. Some teachers may be fantastic on prophecy, but they are useless on practical, day-to-day teaching. On the other hand, some teachers may be really captivating when it comes to devotional preaching, but they'll be useless on doctrine! You've got to constantly be judging everything by the scriptures. Not by what feels good! There are churches out there, particularly amongst the Pentecostals, that major on devotional teaching and preaching. We all need to listen to this at times, to be built up in the areas of compassion, care, sincerity, affection, patience, empathy and to grow in love towards the Lord! But if all you are feeding on is devotional studies, not backed up by sound doctrine, you'll eventually stray into error. A good example of this, is how the church of England teach the sermon on the mount, and the "Golden Rule" of Matthew 7:12. There are many great lessons to be learned from those verses of scripture, but if you are going to take these verses doctrinally, you'll find that this is impossible! Christians who are not grounded in sound doctrine easily become discouraged, because they fail to read these portions of scripture in their right contexts! If all you feed on is devotional, lovey-dovey studies, you'll be easy pickings for the many heretics, atheists, religious liberals and false teachers that are out there, teaching works salvation, attacking the deity of Christ and the word of God. Again, the key is to be a balanced believer!

I want to be a balanced Christian, and this is what I am seeking guidance from the Lord about at present. If you follow a handful of Christian teachers, authors, preachers and ministries, make sure that you are getting a "balanced diet", because what you feed on will affect you, in one way or another.

How would you describe your relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ?

Do you feel a million miles away from Him, or are you walking in close communion with Him? What are the reasons? Is the Lord Jesus Christ the central focus and purpose of your life, or are there things and others above Him? How much do you really love the Lord? Why is it that some Christians are totally sold out to serving Him, when others aren't bothered or interested at all, why is that? Why is there such a contrast among Christians? What are your goals in life? Do you ever think about life 'after' death, and meeting the Lord? Do you have a passion to reach lost souls with the Gospel, or couldn't you care less? How do you love someone more? Have you even pondered on what the Lord Jesus Christ has done for YOU? Does it convict you, to the point that you want to live for Him in everything? Are you on fire for the Lord or just lukewarm? Are your thoughts taken up with the Lord, or do you hardly ever think about Him? You can tell who really loves the Lord, by the way they talk and live. Even at The Oaks, you can tell those who are sold out to Him and those who are living in a backslidden state, even though they would never admit it. They are too proud to admit their coldness and failure. It's sad to see so many Christians who just don't really love the Lord Jesus Christ much; I see it all the time, I just don't understand it to be honest. How can any Christian not be totally, absolutely, 'sold out' to following, living, and serving the Lord, after all He has done for us? What are you running after in life? What are you focused on? What things are important to YOU in your life? How come these are more important to you than the Lord is? How did you get into this position? Where did it all start going wrong? What got a hold of you, and led you away from loving and serving the Lord? Are you really honest?

They believe in a 'mentally ascending gospel'.





A few of my own thoughts on life at present...



Prov 11v13 A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter. You know something about another that isn't 'good'? So, what are you going to do, tell others? How nasty Christians can be at times. What happened to obeying this verse? Who are you judging others by, your standards? There are way too many Christian gossips in the local church. Rather than hurt others, talk to the Lord and allow Him to sort situations out, rather than you jumping in with your big fat feet causing problems everywhere. There is a time to speak, and a time to keep your big mouth closed and let the Lord work.

The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender. Prov 22v7.

How true this is... bang up to date in 2023. If you are borrowing money, you're servant to the lender, they call the shots and you can't beat the system. Don't overspend; don't live above your means. Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Prov 30v8. Stay humble seeking the Lord's will.

Questioned, being questioned, and asking questions...!

(In the OT God is looking for man... 4,000 years of history later, and man is looking for God!)

What's the motive to your question?

Mat 22v35 (Prov 26v4)

Mark 8v11+12

Mark 11v27-33

Luke 23v8-10 (Ecc 3v7, Isa 53v7)

Life is full of questions...

Where did we come from?

Where do we go when we die?

What is the meaning of life?

What's the purpose to it all?

Why am I here?

There's a lot of things we want to know isn't there? - Dan 2v3 ('dreams' for instance...! Why? What do they mean?)

The more you read the Bible the more questions arise. The deeper you go into the Scriptures the bigger the Book gets.

There are some things we're NOT to know - Acts 1v6+7, Mat 24v3+36, Dan 12v4+8+9, Gen 3v5.

There are certain things in life you're best NOT knowing about, or seeking after...

Deut 29v29

Judges 13v17-22 (v18)

Stay as pure as you can for as long as you can, especially protecting your children from all the evil out there. Be careful what they watch, listen to, and get involved with. Phil 4v8, 1 Tim 5v22, Titus 1v15+16.

You learn by asking questions, that's why I encourage all of you to ask questions with the right motive.

What do you want to know? - Acts 2v28, Rom 16v25-27.

You want to know...

God's will for your life - where you should be and what you should do.

The 'times and seasons' for the return of the Lord.

You want to understand the Scriptures.

You want to understand about life - how to think, act, pray etc.

Read Prov 30v12+13 - that's today in 2023.

Rom 2v7-11 - choices to make. You choose how you want to live.

John 14v1-3, 1 Cor 2v9, 1 Thes 4v11-18.

(If you've looked up every verse you've certainly had a blessing...!)

I know it's hard to imagine, but this day is coming...

Rev 21v4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. Think how amazing this will be. Read the verse again...! No more death, crying, pain, sorrow... imagine what kind of place this is going to be.

Controlling your emotions... your temper... do you?

What winds you up? How do you cope with things that annoy and anger you? Have you a short fuse or do you let things go, and forgive? Is this something that you need to work on and ask the Lord to help you with? 1 Cor 9v27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway. Discipline... are you good at it? Who did you last fall out with and why? Should you have done more?



Well, those of you who have been with us for many years can see how Time for Truth! has grown. It's amazing where the Lord has taken us, and we are very grateful and thankful as to how He has used us to reach thousands across the world. Why people like DUNGslinger go wrong so often...

Prov 24v6 For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety. Who are you accountable to? Who is checking what you do, and guiding you? Who are you leaning on and talking to? If you go it alone, you'll fail, guaranteed, because your self-delusion and pride will mess you up as it has done with all Christians who isolate themselves. I don't know of one sound Christian who has cut themselves off from everyone and is normal. They are all whack-heads who deviate from the truth and follow after self-righteousness and start attacking the Body of Christ... that's all they do with the rest of their lives. They waste everything the Lord has ever given them. DUNGslinger is a castaway (1 Cor 9v27) and useless now. He's lost his mind and only a few mentally unstable morons follow him. Don't cut yourself off and try to go it alone, it will never work, NEVER. I've even seen it with people who were once in our own church, and now they are wandering around in the wilderness with no purpose, no guidance, and answer to no one. They too have lost the plot, and now through arrogance, pride, and self-righteousness, have destroyed their own lives. They won't listen and are unteachable.

What a Psalm for life...

- Ps 107v1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;
- 3 And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south.
- 4 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.
- 5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.
- 6 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses.
- 7 And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation.
- 8 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 9 For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness.
- 10 Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron;
- 11 Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High: (The Lord knows what is best for us at all times, but we must be living in His word)
- 12 Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and there was none to help. (We all need to be broken at times...!)
- 13 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses. (When you cry, He saves...!)
- 14 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder. (He sets us free)
- 15 **Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!** (Have you praised the Lord recently?)
- 16 For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder. (Nothing is too hard for the Lord)
- 17 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.
- 18 Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death.
- 19 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. (He saves and helps 'fools' and kings alike... if you call upon Him, He will save you and help you... are you calling upon Him?)
- 20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
- 21 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! (Have you praised and thanked God all week?)
- 22 And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.
- 23 They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters;
- 24 **These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep**. (Every seaman has stories that you wouldn't believe... He's seen things that most of us haven't. The power of the wind and sea etc.)
- 25 **For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof**. (He controls the weather and He controls the 'storms in your life')
- 26 They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.
- 27 They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wits' end. (Are you at your 'wits end'... have you reached 'rock-bottom' yet?)
- 28 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses. (Have you cried to the Lord yet?)
- 29 He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. (There it is... He calms the storm... He creates it, and then calms it... and there is a perfect reason that He knows, as to why we have to go through certain things. We try to work it out and fathom it, but we just can't at times, not until we've come through it. Rom 11v33 O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!) 30 Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven. (Once the storm has passed, there is a peace, like you've never known John 14v27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. Phil 4v7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Col 3v15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.)
- 31 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! (Never stop thanking and praising God... in everything... including the storms of life... just keep trusting in Him Luke 8v23-25 But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy. And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm. And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! for he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him.

Mark 4v37 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. 38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?

- 39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.
- 40 And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?
- 41 And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?) Every storm you come up against... He knows, and He understands what and why you're going through it. Trust in Him to get you through.
- 32 Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.
- 33 **He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground**; Whatever state you are in, in life, He can turn it around and sort it all out, if you put your faith and trust in Him... but do you? Or... do you run to the doctor, tablets, drugs, booze, men etc?
- 34 A fruitful land into barrenness, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein.
- 35 He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings.
- 36 And there he maketh the hungry to dwell, that they may prepare a city for habitation;
- 37 And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.
- 38 He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly; and suffereth not their cattle to decrease.
- 39 Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow.
- 40 He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way.
- 41 Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock.
- 42 The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. (Titus 1v11...!)
- 43 Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. (Do you understand the lovingkindness of the Lord?)

What a Psalm... I said... WHAT A PSALM...!!! Did you get much out of that...? I certainly did. It helps me to deal with the storms in my own life. Without the Lord at the helm (James 3v4) guiding me, I haven't got a clue...! Studying the 'storms' in Scripture would make a great Bible study I'm sure.

I am so thankful to the Lord for getting me through another tough week, and landing me safely on the shore.

I want to thank Him and praise Him, and love Him with everything I have.

A flurry of responses from our tracts...



Again, because you don't have to answer to 'a boss', you can also have more freedom to talk, witness and discuss things with your customers should they want to go down that route. Like all things in this life and world, nothing is full proof and things can go as quickly as they came, that's why you have to trust the Lord daily for your provision etc. Mat 6v11 **Give us this day our daily bread**. Every day we pray and seek God to bless us and help us through it. We have opportunities to stand for Him and upon His word, witnessing and sharing the Gospel with many in our industry. Regarding work, setting up on our own was the best decision we ever made, and through it, we've been able to bless others in the ministry and in the world. The Lord, through JDA, finances the ministry. Any gifts over and above are extra blessings which also go into the ministry. We are a Christian company, and we seek to put the Lord Jesus first in everything, seeking His blessing and give all the praise and honour to His name. Thank you Lord Jesus for JDA.

Is it time you moved on?

Is it time for you to make some changes? Don't waste time.

Are you just fed up with some people?

There are people in my own life that just don't listen. They make so many mistakes because they ignore counsel, even when they pretend to take heed to it. Due to this, they either stay as they are or get worse, and go off course.

Prov 11v14 Where no counsel is, the people fall: but in the multitude of counsellors there is safety.

Prov 15v22 Without counsel purposes are disappointed: but in the multitude of counsellors they are established.

Prov 24v6 For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety.

We all need counsel; we all need advice and help at times. Who have you tried to help recently; did they listen? Has anyone tried to help you, did you listen?
