The meaning of apartheid

LETTERS published in the JEP recently from Senator Manton, Mrs Capey and Mr Troalic indicate that apartheid is as much an issue today as it was when I was here with my family twelve months ago. (I still have a copy of Senator Manton's splendidly informative letter of July '85.) This is not surprising of course, in view of recent events.

In any discussion it always helps to have an occasional reminder of what words mean. "Apartheid" literally means "separatedness." This literal meaning has, in my view, become somewhat obscured over the years. If one retains the literal meaning of the word, it is immediately apparent that none other than the Lord God Almighty is responsible for apartheid in Genesis 1:2 dividing the light from the darkness, again in Genesis 1:7, dividing the waters, again in Genesis 1:14; dividing the day from the night, again in Leviticus 11:47; making a difference between **unclean** and clean and again in Deuteronomy 32:8; "When the most high divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel." He also discriminated between the sons of Noah, Genesis 9, blessing Shem, the asiatic, blessing Japheth, the European-literally "the fair one," but cursing Canaan the son of Ham, from whence come the negroid peoples. Ham's sin, which earned him the curse transmitted through his descendents, was sodomy. See Genesis 9:22, 24; Leviticus 18, 20. The Bible also shows that God separated the races into three continents, Africa being the land of Ham. Psalm 78:51, 106:22.

God's purpose in apartheid with respect to races and nations is that they should seek the

Lord. Acts 17:26, 27. When races and nations get together, the catch-phrase of apostates like Desmond Tutu, they amalgamate into an ecumenical, international, multi-everything, diabolical, God-defying tower of Babel. Genesis 11:1-9.

We are seeing the beginning of this with the Catholic, Communist United Nations, dedicated to the overthrow by any means of all opposition such as Protestant South Africa and Protestant Northern Ireland. Only the tactics differ. In South Africa, the minority rule is white and Protestant; therefore minority rule is wrong. In Northern Ireland, the majority rule is white and Protestant; therefore majority rule is wrong. It is rather like a whore changing her allure to suit her clients. Revelation 17, 18. (You could not miss the identity of the "harlot on the seven hills" unless you were blind and could not read braille.) As Senator Manton rightly points out, it is the world's media that leads the way, moulding the necessary attitudes and opinions. It is instructive therefore to look briefly at some truths which receive scant attention from the media, as Senator Manton rightly does.

The media makes little or no mention of the results of anti-apartheid, or race mixing. Integration of school pupils in the USA led directly to 100,000 assaults on teachers and pupils in one year, a 400 per cent increase in venereal disease, an 800 per cent increase in illegitimate births and a 40 per cent decrease in literacy standards. Millions of dollars were wasted busing pupils who did not want to be mixed. (Majority rule, was it) The US politicians who brought in integration sent their kids to all white schools.

The media pays little attention to the record of black African states since independence. Has the Biafran war

been so completely forgotten, when the Ibo tribespeople were slaughtered in thousands by fellow blacks? This alone makes nonsense out of Nigeria's present posturing. What about Mugabe's 5th Brigade in Matabeleland? Memories are very short. Idi Amin slaughtered more blacks in ten years than any group of white men since the year 1500 and Milton Obote surpassed even him. In sum, the present furore about South Africa is rather like complaining about a spot of milk on the floor of an abattoir.

Over the past twenty years the United Kingdom, specifically England, has developed a rather unsavoury tendency to sell out her friends in order to appease her enemies. Witness Rhodesia, South Africa and Ulster. In the 1930s the French coined the expression "Albion Perfide." Having been abandoned once, see Mr Le Brun's letter, JEP, 9 July, Jersey people will, I am sure, take careful note as Catholic Communism reaches

its climax in the next decade. Revelation 13, 17, 18.

Naturally, Bible rejecting "Christians" will howl at the above disclosures from the infallible AV 1611. This is because "Christians" long ago lost interest in the book and were for the most part seduced by the media like the rest of society. We may note that with the adoption of the media stance on race-mixing, African morals, African music and African style nakedness, see Mr Renault's letter, JEP 9 July, are increasingly featured in the church as well as in secular society. Finally, if this letter produces any kind of negative reaction from readers — Christian or otherwise — it only goes to prove that there's no smoke without fire and that a hit dog usually yells when it is hit.
