Who is Jesus Christ?

Jesus Christ is God

I thank the **Lord Jesus Christ** that thousands of these booklets have been distributed all over the UK and worldwide, to help combat all the heresies, cults, and false religions we see today. This is the reason I wrote it. I have now updated it.

Jesus Christ is not only the Son of God, but He IS God, although of course, He is NOT the Father.

A conclusive test as to whether you are talking to a heretic or not, is what they believe about **Jesus Christ**. If they say He is <u>NOT</u> God, or He <u>IS</u> the Father, you <u>know</u> you are dealing with a member of a cult.

This booklet will give you enough Scripture to combat all the heretics, from the cults of the Jehovah's Witnesses (JW), Christadelphians, Jesus Only, and Mormons, to all the false religions such as, Islam, Sikhism, Buddhism etc.

We have received some amazing testimonies regarding 'Jesus Christ IS God', one of which was a prisoner in the UK who received a copy, read and studied it while in prison, got saved through it, and then passed it on to other prisoners who also did the same and received the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour. It was truly an amazing testimony.

It would also be very beneficial for you to look up every Scripture reference in a **King James Bible**, and not in one of these modern perverted 'bibles' like the NIV, ESV, NKJV, NASB, GNB, RV, RSV etc. as they have all been corrupted, and are full of errors. If you do not know about the 'version issue' yet, then I would highly recommend you looking at our website **www.timefortruth.co.uk**. You can also request our FREE booklet 'Which Bible is THE word of God'.

The pure and inerrant words of God (all of them!) are found today, perfectly preserved, in the **King James Bible**.

Note - There is no such thing as 'THE' Greek, as there are over one hundred *different* Greek texts.

You either believe that God is powerful enough to give us a perfect Bible or He isn't. We believe He is.

In order for the cults and false religions to teach that Jesus Christ is *not* God, they have to add, subtract, distort, or change the Scriptures. As Bible believers, we don't do that. In this study, we prove that Jesus Christ IS God, yet NOT the Father, from the Holy Scriptures, with nothing added or taken away, leaving the Scriptures in context, as we find them.

First of all, let us look at a verse in the Bible that nearly every cult will remove or distort. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. 1 John 5v7. This causes a great

problem for the cults and false religions that want to teach that Jesus is not equal with the Father and that He is not God. Phil 2v5-11 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

What the cults have to do is change the word of God to teach a lie. JW's do this all the time with their corrupt 'New World Translation bible'. (The JW's have written their own 'bible' based upon corrupt manuscripts (Westcott and Hort's Greek Text) i.e. Codex B-Vaticanus and Codex Aleph-Sinaiticus – these manuscripts disagree with each other over 3,000 times in just the Gospels alone; how about that for accuracy!) The Mormons have to add a whole new book to the Scriptures to teach their own errors i.e. the Book of Mormon. 1 John 5v7 categorically states that the Father, the Word (which is Jesus Christ) and the Holy Ghost are one. That is what it says without any interpretation or opinion, the 'three' are 'one'. No wonder the cults change or remove this verse from their counterfeit-bibles.

'I and My Father are One' - The Jews in Christ's day went to stone the Lord Jesus Christ because He *claimed* to be God in the flesh... John 10v30-33 <u>I and my Father are one</u>. Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him. Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, <u>makest thyself God</u>.

The Jews understood who Jesus 'claimed' to be, hence why they wanted to stone Him. So just by these Scriptures already, we can see that God is three separate Persons, Father, Son (i.e. the Word – note capital 'W') and Holy Spirit, yet there is one God.

It is also very interesting that the word 'Godhead' appears three times in Scripture.

- 1) Acts 17v29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the <u>Godhead</u> is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.
- 2) Rom 1v20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- 3) Col 2v9 For in him (Jesus Christ) dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

The words **Almighty God** also appear three times in Scripture.

- Gen 17v1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the <u>Almighty God</u>; walk before me, and be thou perfect.
- 2) Eze 10v5 And the sound of the cherubims' wings was heard even to the outer court, as the voice of the Almighty God when he speaketh.
- 3) Rev 19v15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of <u>Almighty God</u>.

God's fingerprints are often seen in 'three's'... There is something special about the number three.

In the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, He was raised on the <u>third</u> day (Mat 12v38-40) by the Divine <u>three</u> in the Godhead - God the Father raised Him (Gal 1v1), Jesus raised Himself (John 2v19-21), and the Holy Spirit raised Him (Rom 8v11) (*Ask a JW to explain that one and watch him run for cover!*) The number three also shows the imprint of the Godhead in the universe as you can see in our table on page 4.

The number three (3)...

Some numbers in the Bible have 'primary' and 'secondary' meanings.

The number three's *primary* meaning is **Godhead** (aka the Trinity).

- 1) Mat 28v19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.
- 2) In Mat 3v16+17 Jesus was baptised (1), the Spirit of God descended (2), and the Father spoke (3).
- 3) 1 John 5v7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

The *secondary* meaning is **resurrection**.

- 1) The Gospel of the grace of God is the death (1), burial (2) and resurrection (3) 1 Cor 15v1-4.
- 2) Jesus raised three people from the dead in His earthly ministry the widows son, Jarius's daughter and Lazarus.
- 3) Israel is to be raised as a nation on the third day (Hos 6v2).

That special number 'three' is everywhere...

So, getting back to our study proving from the word of God, the Scriptures, that Jesus Christ is God...

John 1v1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1v14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Who is 'the <u>W</u>ord?' 'The <u>W</u>ord' (note the capital 'W') is Jesus Christ – Jesus Christ is God.

1 John 1v1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of <u>the Word of life</u>; The 'Word' is Jesus Christ.

Rev 19v11-13 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called <u>The Word of God</u>. The Word is Jesus Christ.

1 Tim 3v16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: <u>God was manifest in the flesh</u>, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the **Gentiles**, believed on in the world, received up into glory. God *here* is Jesus Christ - Jesus Christ is God.

But what do the cults and false religions do with the above Scriptures? Peter tells us... 2 Pet 3v16 **As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable (All the cults and false religions) wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. They wrest (distort) the Scriptures to their own destruction. Regarding adding, subtracting and distorting the word of God look up the following Scriptures... Deut 4v2, Prov 30v5+6, Ecc 3v14, Rev 22v18+19.**

All we have done so far is looked at Scripture, comparing 'spiritual' with 'spiritual' (1 Cor 2v13-16), Scripture with Scripture. Notice we haven't changed one single word of the Bible neither have we run to any Greek or Hebrew text to try to prove *anything*.

Jesus Christ is God - The JW cult insist that 'LORD' (note all capitals) refers to Jehovah God the Father, while 'Lord' refers to the Son (a lesser 'god'), but the truth of the matter is that the Lord Jesus Christ was often referred to in the Old Testament (OT) as Jehovah God Himself, yet not the Father. For example, look at the following verses... Zech 12v7-10 The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah. In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them. And it shall come to pass

in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Now how about that, Jehovah God saying they shall look upon ME whom they have pierced (crucified). Jesus Christ is Jehovah God. The Father was not pierced.

Rev 1v5-7 And from <u>Jesus Christ</u>, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. Behold, <u>he (Jesus)</u> cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which <u>pierced him</u>: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

Isa 44v6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God. Note the 'LORD' for the Father and the 'LORD' for the Son – both are God, yet both are not the same. Both are the First and the Last. Rev 1v17+18 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death. (This is Jesus Christ speaking i.e. 'the First and the Last') God the Father wasn't crucified, God the Son was. God the Father didn't die, Jesus Christ died - I am the first and the last - I am he that liveth, and was dead. Just by comparing Scripture with Scripture you can see clearly that Jesus Christ is GOD.

Who is Jesus Christ?

Well, He had no beginning and existed *before* He came to earth (Mic 5v2, John 17v5, John 1v1+2, John 8v58). Matthew traces Him back to Abraham (Mat 1v1-17), Luke to Adam (Luke 3v23-38) and John to God (John 1v1+2). Jesus Himself said that He was 'Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End' (Rev 1v8+11). Look up John 10v30, John 1v14. Jesus Christ's 'work' is of threefold, **Prophet** (Deut 18v15+18 cf. John 1v21, 6v14, Acts 3v22+23), **Priest** (Heb 2v17, 3v1, 4v14+15, 5v8-11, 6v20, 7v25+26, 8v1-6, 9v11) and **King** (1 Tim 6v15, Rev 17v14, 19v16).

Prophet – from creation to His ascension.

Priest – from His ascension to the Rapture.

King – from His Revelation (2nd Advent) until He surrenders His Kingdom to the Father, that God may be 'All in all' (1 Cor 15v28).

Jesus Christ in creation – Col 1v14-19, John 1v1-3, Gen 1v26 (note 'us') – Read also Isa 40, Job 38+39. Jesus Christ is throughout the whole Bible, where God is mentioned, through whatever name used, Christ is there (1 John 5v7). Jesus Christ is Jehovah, Jesus Christ is God, but Jesus Christ is NOT the Father, (Heb 1v5-8, 2 John 1v3, 1 John

1v3, Mat 24v36) nor the Holy Spirit. The Godhead is made up of three 'Persons' (not 'humans') – 1 John 5v7. The word 'Godhead' appears three times in Scripture (Acts 17v29, Rom 1v20, Col 2v9) and so do the words 'Almighty God' (Gen 17v1, Ezek 10v5, Rev 19v15).

As one Bible teacher said in regard to the Godhead (aka Trinity) – God is a Trinity. He is not three gods (tritheism). Nor is He one God manifested as three personalities (modalism). He is one God, eternally existing in Three **Persons** - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This is a truth impossible to comprehend yet clearly taught in the Bible. These three are identical in essence, equal in power and glory, having the same attributes and perfections, and being worthy of the same reverence, confidence and submission (Deut 6v4, Mat 28v19+20, Luke 3v22, 2 Cor 13v14, Eph 2v18, 1 John 5v7).

As a Prophet, Jesus Christ foretold His death and resurrection, among many other prophetic statements – see Mat 24+25. No other 'religious leader' ever, has done what the Lord did in all His prophetical statements, and no other 'holy book' ever, does what the Bible does in regard to prophecy. Both the Lord Jesus Christ and the King James Bible are unique, perfect, and should be adhered to – John 5v39, John 6v68, 1 Pet 1v23. (For a list of 351 prophecies regarding Jesus Christ please see the back of this booklet).

Jesus Christ had to put right what Adam messed up - Read Rom 5v12-21. We inherit our sin nature from Adam (Gen 5v1-3) and being in this body of flesh (Rom 7v14-25), we still sin until we get our resurrected redeemed body at the Rapture (Rom 8v23, 1 John 3v2, Phil 3v20+21, 1 Cor 15v50-57). Adam was born innocent and if he'd have taken the right road, would have become righteous, but instead he chose the wrong path and became a 'sinner'. If he'd have taken that step to righteousness, he would have been permitted to eat from the 'Tree of Life' and live forever in a state of holiness. Adam and Eve had no children before the 'Fall', if they had, they would have been born innocent. The children Adam begat after the 'Fall' were born sinners (Ps 51v5), therefore the whole human race became sinners by inheritance – Rom 5v12. Men die because they are sinners. The penalty of Adam's sin was both spiritual and physical death, and the only way the human race could be saved from both, is by someone paying the penalty for them, and that was Jesus Christ, hence why He had to become a 'man' (John 19v5, 1 Tim 2v5, Heb 10v5+10 – now read all of Heb 10). Jesus couldn't be born 'a sinner', and so in order to do this, He had to somehow get rid of the inherited sinful nature, and this was done through the 'cutting off' of the human blood line (as there's death in the blood as it's been corrupted - Lev 17v11, 1 Cor 15v50, Col 1v14) and being born of a virgin (1 Pet 1v18, Acts 20v28, Isa 7v14, Mat 1v23, Luke 1v27). He would have no taint of sin because He didn't have a 'human' father (Luke 2v33 – check this verse out in other 'bibles' e.g. NIV, ESV etc.), therefore He was born holy – Luke 1v35. Because of this, Jesus was now 'qualified' to make an atonement for the sin of mankind. Because of Jesus Christ taking our sins upon Himself and the penalty of our sins (2 Cor 5v21), we can be pardoned (1 Pet 3v18). There was no sin

in the Lord, only sins 'on' Him, and they were our sins (1 John 3v5, Heb 4v15, 9v14, 1 Pet 2v22, Isa 53v9, John 18v38, John 19v4+6), He was the perfect sacrifice – Heb 9+10, never to repeated, hence why the Roman Catholic 'Mass'... is a Satanic mess. Roman Catholicism is the Antichrist Church (Rev 17).

Note here the sufferings of the Lord Jesus Christ for us – Isa 52v14, Isa 50v6, Ps 129v3, Luke 22v63-65, Ps 22, John 18v19-23, John 19v1-3, Isa 53, Mat 26v67+68, Mat 27v28-31, Mark 10v34, 14v65, 15v17-20.

Note the Blood of Jesus Christ and how imperative, efficacious and powerful it is – Eph 2v13, Heb 9v22, 1 John 1v7+9, Eph 1v7, Heb 10v10-19, Rom 5v9, Heb 13v12, Rev 1v5, Eph 2v13, 1 Pet 3v21, Col 1v14 cf. Exo 12, Heb 9+10, Lev 17v11-14 (Gen 2v7), Acts 17v26, Rev 12v10+11, Heb 12v24, Rev 7v14, Col 1v20. You cannot have your sins forgiven and washed away, without applying the Blood of Jesus Christ – the 'Blood Atonement'.

Justification only comes through Jesus Christ and His shed Blood – Rom 3v20-31, Rom 5v1+9, 1 Cor 6v11, Acts 13v38+39, Gal 2v16+21, Gal 3v11, Titus 3v7 – it has nothing to do with any kind of 'work' – Eph 2v8+9, Rom 11v6, Titus 3v5-7, Rom 3v24, Titus 2v11, 2 Tim 1v9, Rom 4v6 – 'water baptism' cannot save you (1 Cor 1v17).

Note Jesus Christ died for ALL not just the 'elect' as the Calvinistic cult teaches – Heb 2v9, 1 John 2v2, 2 Cor 5v14+15, Rom 5v6-8, (2 Pet 3v9, John 3v16), 1 Tim 2v4-6, 1 Tim 4v10, 2 Pet 2v1, 1 John 4v14, Rom 10v13, John 12v47, Rom 11v32, John 6v51.

All men die because all men are sinners (Rom 5v12). The penalty of Adam's sin was both spiritual and physical death, which then passed upon the whole human race. This is why Jesus Christ came, to pay the penalty not only for Adam's sin, but everyone's. This is why Jesus Christ not only had to come into the world as a man, but a sinless man, hence why he could not inherit any sin, that is why His birth must be that of a virgin, i.e. not a 'human' father. Christ's blood was God's blood, perfect and sinless (1 Pet 1v18+19, Acts 20v28). Being sinless, Jesus 'qualified' to make an atonement for sin.

The 'Principle of Law' is that the penalty of a broken Law must fall on the breaker of the Law, or on a substitute, otherwise the Law is of no effect. An atonement then, is any provision that may be introduced into the administration of a government, whereby that government may on just, safe, and honourable grounds, grant a pardon to the offender.

Adam broke the Law and the penalty for breaking the Law was death, spiritually and physically. The penalty, therefore, must be paid by Adam or a substitute (1 Pet 3v18, 2 Cor 5v21). A lamb was the sacrifice that covered his sin until 'The Lamb', God Himself in the flesh (Gen 22v8, John 1v29, Exo 12, Isa 53, Gen 3v15, 1 Tim 3v16), took away his sins (Heb 9+10, Col 2v13+14, John 1v17). When Jesus Christ died on that Cross, 'Justice' and 'Mercy' met, and the wrath of God was pacified, providing a way back for

man to be reconciled to his God (Rom 5v10, 2 Cor 5v18, 2 Cor 5v20). The penalty of 'spiritual death' was paid when Jesus cried "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?" (Ps 22v1, Mat 27v46); and the penalty of 'physical death' was paid when Jesus cried "...It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost." John 19v30. Note the first words recorded from the lips of the Lord Jesus Christ were... "...wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?" Luke 2v49, and His last words... "It is finished" (John 17v1-5). As sinners we were under the curse of the Law, but as believers, Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the Law (Gal 3v13, 2 Cor 5v21, Acts 13v39, Rom 10v4, Rom 7v4, Gal 5v4, Gal 2v16-20, Gal 3v11, John 1v17).

The Lord Jesus Christ's present work is that of our Great High Priest (Heb 4v14, Heb 3v1, Heb 7v26, Heb 9v24) who has entered through the 'veil' into the Holy of Holies (the Heavenly Tabernacle), through the 'Veil of the Cloud', out of earthly view (Acts 1v9) to present His blood and make intercession for our sins. Heaven, not earth, is the sphere of Christ's 'Priestly' ministry. The Lord Jesus Christ, as our High Priest, still tarries, engaged in His Priestly work, and will continue to do so throughout this 'Great Day of Atonement' until He comes again. Then He will lay aside His High Priestly robes and come forth in His Kingly dress of 'Glory and Beauty', coming as King of kings and Lord of lords (Rev 19v11-16), to rule and reign as King.

At present He is our Advocate (1 John 2v1+2), not for our sin, as that was atoned and paid for on the Cross (Eph 2v16, Col 1v20, Col 2v14, Col 1v14), but for our 'sins', those that we commit since becoming a Christian... we still sin (1 John 1v8), but there is a huge difference between our 'standing' and our 'state'. Our standing is that we are a son of God (John 1v12+13, 1 John 3v1+2), and joint heirs with Christ (Rom 8v17), therefore we have 'eternal security' (1 Pet 1v4+5, John 3v16, John 6v39, John 10v27-29, Eph 4v30, Col 3v3 – see also pages 65-68 in my book Christian Soldier's Battle Notes volume one). So, our standing is settled and sure, but our 'state' can be something else and varies at times. Even after the New Birth (John 3v5-7) we still have our old nature in the flesh (Rom 7v14-25). We can break our fellowship with God, but not our relationship, just like a father and son can have a break-up, but the son is still his father's son no matter what. We are saved for eternity and can never lose our salvation.

Soon Jesus Christ will come again, known as 'the Rapture' (1 Cor 15v51-54, 1 Thes 4v13-18), then approximately seven years later He'll return as King, to set up His Kingdom after the Second Advent, which leads into the Millennium, the 1,000-year reign of Jesus Christ on earth.

So, when the Lord finishes His High Priestly work, He leaves His Father's Throne to meet His espoused wife (Bride of Christ, the Church) at the Rapture. He will then take His wife back to Heaven and take His place upon the Judgment Seat (Rom 14v10), not the Great White Throne (Rev 20v11). He will then proceed to judge and reward the saints according to their works, after which He will present the Church to Himself (Eph 5v27). Then follows the Marriage of the Lamb (Rev 19v6-9).

After this, and after receiving the Kingdom from His Father, the Lord Jesus, accompanied by the armies of Heaven, will descend to the earth and the Battle of Armageddon will take place (Rev 19v11-21). Following this, the Lord will sit upon the 'Throne of His Glory' and judge the nations (Mat 25v31-46), then once concluded, will set up His Millennial Kingdom.

(Note – for further study on Christ's Throne on earth read... Luke 1v32+33, Dan 2v44, Dan 7v18+27, Rom 15v12, Mat 25v31, Zech 14v9, Mat 19v28, Isa 9v6+7, Jer 30v9, Ezek 34v22-31, Ezek 37v1-28, Hos 3v3-5, Acts 15v13-17, 2 Sam 7v12-16, 2 Sam 3v10, 1 Kings 1v35, 1 Kings 2v12, Ps 59v13, Ps 122v5, Ps 132v11. Don't confuse the Father's Throne, with the Lord's Throne in Heaven, nor with the Lord's Throne on earth. Rightly divide the Scriptures (2 Tim 2v15) or you will wrongly join them).

At the close of the 1,000-year Millennial Kingdom, Satan is let loose from the 'Bottomless Pit' and man will follow him again, with the fulfilment of this dispensation ending also in failure, as does *every* dispensation. Fire from Heaven will destroy the wicked, Satan will be finally dealt with, permanently (Rev 20), and there will be a New Heaven and a New Earth (2 Pet 3v13, Rev 21v1).

The Godhead aka The Trinity

Everyone who says that the Trinity is a Roman Catholic invention, is either deluded or a liar. Even KJV only so-called Bible 'believers' have fallen for lies regarding the Trinity e.g. the Jesus only cult, Modalism, Arianism, Polytheism etc. God is not three 'modes' or 'parts'. There are some Christians who teach the heresy that Jesus is the Father, He is not. All because man is trying to 'work out' God, he gets himself into some untenable positions at times. In John 1v18 we find the NASB and NIV teaching there are two 'God's'.

Now, there is one God (Deut 6v4), the Creator (Gen 1v1), yet this one God exists in three 'Persons'. The Godhead is Almighty God. Now I am one body, yet Scripturally speaking I am made up of three separate 'parts' (body, soul, spirit – Gen 2v7, 1 Thes 5v23, Heb 4v12), everyone is. If you're not saved you are a body, a soul, yet you have a dead spirit that needs to be 'born-again' (John 3v3-7). So, I am a type, a picture of God, yet, He is three Persons, NOT 'parts' (Gen 1v26+27, Gen 3v22). Now in all honesty, no one can really fully understand the Godhead / Trinity (Isa 55v8+9), it's impossible, but we can learn something about the one God yet three Persons of the Godhead. Most Christians fall out over the doctrine of the Trinity because they play semantic games on words e.g. 'person' vs 'part' or 'mode'. We can understand something of the Godhead from nature (Rom 1v19-22) e.g. the sun giving off alpha, beta and gamma rays, yet one sun; or, light, heat and energy, yet still one sun. Another illustration is water, which can take three forms, liquid, ice and steam. These are pictures and types in nature where we can learn about God.

When we 'say'... God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, we are not saying three God's (1+1+1=3), we are saying that Jesus Christ is God, the Holy Spirit

is God, and the Father is God (1x1x1=1). 1 John 5v7, Mat 28v19 (note here it says baptising them in the 'name', NOT 'names' ... of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost). There is only one name that will match the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost, and that is 'the Lord'. Jesus Christ is not the Father, and the Father is not Jesus Christ. The Godhead is made up of three separate 'Persons' – 2 Cor 13v14. God also speaks of Himself in the plural as we've already touched upon in Gen 1v26, not a plurality of 'Gods'.

We see the Godhead / Trinity at work throughout the Bible e.g. in the baptism of the Lord Jesus Christ (Mat 3v13-17). Let us look at a few more examples of the Godhead and how they work together in unity...

God is eternal, from everlasting, He had no beginning...

Father – Rom 16v26, Deut 33v27, Ps 90v2, Isa 40v28, 1 Tim 1v17. **Son** – Mic 5v2, Rev 1v8. **Holy Spirit** – Heb 9v14, 1 Cor 2v14.

God is omnipresent (everywhere)

Father – Jer 23v24. **Son** – Mat 18v20, Mat 28v20, Eph 1v23, 2 Cor 13v5. **Holy Spirit** – Ps139v7-10.

God is omnipotent (All powerful)

Father – Jer 32v17, 1 Chron 29v11, Mat 19v26, Luke 1v37, 1 Pet1v5. **Son** – Mat 28v18, Heb 1v3, John 5v21-23, 2 Cor 12v9, Mat 8v26+27, Mat 9v23-26, Luke 7v11-16, John 11v43+44, Eph 1v21, Phil 3v20+21. **Holy Spirit** – Rom 15v13+19, Luke 1v35.

God is omniscient (All knowing)

Father – Job 42v2, Ps 139v1-4, Ps 147v5, Ps 102v24, Acts 15v18, Heb 4v13, Rom 11v33, Jer 17v10. **Son** – John 16v30, Mat 12v25, John 2v24+25, Col 2v3, Rev 2v23, Mat 9v4, John 21v17, John 1v47-49, John 4v17-19. **Holy Spirit** – Isa 40v13+14, 1 Cor 2v10+11, John 16v12+13.

Each Person of the Godhead aka The Trinity is called God

Father – Gen 1v1, John 17v3. **Son** – John 20v28, 1 John 5v20, Mat 1v23. **Holy Spirit** – Acts 5v3+4.

Each Person of the Godhead was involved in Creation

Father – Gen 1v1, Mal 2v10, Isa 44v24. **Son** – John 1v3+10, Col 1v16, Heb 1v10. **Holy Spirit** – Job 26v13, Job 33v4, Ps 104v30.

All three Persons of the Godhead raised Jesus from the dead

Father – Gal 1v1, Rom 10v9, Rom 6v4, 1 Cor 6v14, Eph 1v20, Rom 4v24. **Son** – John 2v19-21, John 10v17+18. **Holy Spirit** – Rom 8v11, 1 Pet 3v18.

The Godhead lives within the believer

Father – 1 John 4v12. Son – John 14v20. Holy Spirit – John 14v17.

Let's look a little more at the Godhead... Jesus Christ is NOT the Father – John 3v16, Mat 17v5, 1 Pet 3v18, 2 Cor 5v21, Isa 53v5+10, John 14v6, Eph 2v18, John 16v23, Mat 3v16+17, Mat 26v39, John 14v22+23 (and note the word 'WE' the Godhead), they are separate, yet God. The Godhead maintains absolute separate distinctions between the three, yet they are one. To the human mind it's incomprehensible, yet clearly taught in Scripture. You cannot understand it, you are told to *believe* it. The Father maintains His separate distinction although the same attributes found in Jesus Christ are also ascribed to the Father and vice-versa. The Father is never called 'Christ', 'Jesus Christ', or 'Jesus', as they are NOT the same 'Person'. Someone once said 'He who will try to understand the Trinity fully, will lose his mind, but he who will deny the Trinity will lose his soul'. That's good! The Trinity is a mystery that will remain a mystery until we meet the Lord in glory, yet we believe it. (For a detailed study on the Trinity / Godhead, I would recommend purchasing 'Theological Studies volume one', by Peter Ruckman).

More examples from Scripture proving that Jesus Christ is not the Father...

Read John 8v12-16... Now look carefully at the following two verses... 17+18 It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true. I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me. That's two... not 'Jesus is the Father', that would be one.

John 15v10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. Jesus has commandments and so does His Father... Jesus is not the Father, they are separate, yet both are God.

But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; (not the Father) afterward they that are Christ's at his coming (not the Father). Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father (not the Son); when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 1 Cor 15v23+24.

The Godhead aka the Trinity in the Incarnation - God manifesting Himself 'in flesh'. John 3v16 For God (Father) so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son (Jesus), that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. Mat 17v5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said (the Father), This is my beloved Son (Jesus), in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him. Jesus is not the Father. They work together as they are God, but they are separate. The Holy Spirit was there at the incarnation also... Luke 1v35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. Three separate 'Persons', yet one God.

The Trinity in Redemption - God the Father accepted the sacrifice of His only begotten

Son Jesus Christ... Heb 10v8-12 Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law; Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; Now read 1 Pet 3v18. 2 Cor 5v21 For he (Father) hath made him (Son) to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. Read Isa 53v5+10. The Father and Son are active in redemption. Now look at Heb 9v14 and see the Holy Spirit is also active in redemption.

The Trinity in Salvation - You can't get to the Father without coming through the Son – John 14v6 (John 1v4+17, 8v19+32, 10v9, 11v25, Heb 9v8). We are accepted in the beloved (Eph 1v5+6, Rom 8v29). When you receive Jesus Christ, you are accepted by the Father and placed in His family. Read also Luke 15v4, John 1v11+12. So, we can see that the Father and the Son are active in salvation. But so is the Holy Spirit – Eph 1v13, Eph 4v30, 1 Cor 6.

The Trinity in Communion - God the Father invites us to come to Him for fellowship in Eph 2v18, but this is on the grounds of God the Son (not 'two' Gods – it's terminology...!) being our reconciliation (2 Cor 5v19). It is God the Holy Spirit (not 'three' Gods – it's terminology...!) that effects this union and communion – Eph 2v18. Note that in Rom 8v26+27 we see the Spirit making intercession for us, which shows that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit act conjunctively in prayer. God the Father is the one who receives the request. Requests are made to the Father, but they are made in the name of the Son (John 16v23), and it is God the Holy Spirit who directs us in our requests, and leads and guides us in our praying.

So, the doctrine of the Trinity is not a Roman Catholic doctrine, it is a Biblical doctrine.

(Read the last four lines on page 68, and the first 17 lines on page 69 in Ruckman's Theological Studies volume one)

Attributes of The Trinity - God's (not Gods) incommunicable attributes — His eternity, His omnipotence, His omnipresence and His omniscience. God's (not Gods) communicable attributes — His truth, His benevolence, His communion and His holiness. God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit (not three 'Gods' — one God three 'Persons') all have the same attributes, yet they are distinct 'Persons' not 'human beings'.

Imagine believing Jesus is the Father with this verse... Mat 26v39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt. God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit (not three Gods (remember 1x1x1=1) are members

of the Triune Godhead, just like we have a body, soul and spirit in type. Our body is a picture / type of God the Son; our soul is a picture / type of God the Father, which can neither be seen nor felt; our spirit, like air, is a picture / type of the Holy Spirit, for man was made in the image of God. The Godhead is equal with separate distinctions.

Remember, there is not one single verse of Scripture that says Jesus Christ IS the Father, not one.

John 14v12-16 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (He goes unto the Father, not He is the Father) And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (Note two separate 'Persons') If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. If ye love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, (separate 'Person') and he shall give you another Comforter (separate 'Person'), that he may abide with you for ever; Jesus is not the Father... Jesus is not the Comforter (Holy Spirit). Only cults teach otherwise.

John 15v16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name (note two separate 'Persons'), he may give it you. John 16v23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name (note two separate 'Persons'), he will give it you. You have got to bend and twist Scripture to teach otherwise. This is what the cults do. It is clearly seen throughout all of Scripture that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are God, yet three separate 'Beings', 'Persons'. If anyone teaches otherwise... dump them!

For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will. (Notice separate) For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: (Notice separate) That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. (Notice separate) He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. (Notice separate) John 5v21-23. Jesus Christ is not the Father and the Father is not Jesus Christ, but both are God... one God yet three separate 'Persons'.

Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me (Jesus was taught by the Father), I speak these things. And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him. John 8v28+29. (Note - separate Persons).

So, from the Scriptures you can clearly see who God is, who Jesus Christ is. Those who teach otherwise are distorting the Scriptures to teach a false doctrine. Be careful who you listen to, who you watch, and who you follow. Check everything out comparing Scripture with Scripture (1 Cor 2v13), take nobody's word for anything.

Other interesting information...

Regarding the stumbling stone and rock of offence compare these verses Isa 8v13, Isa 28v16, Deut 32v3+4 with 1 Pet 2v8, Rom 9v33, 1 Cor 10v4.

My Lord and my God – John 20v24-28 and note what Thomas says to Jesus in v28.

Isa 9v6 - A 'child' is *born* but a 'son' is *given* - Note - The son was not 'born' because the Son of God is from everlasting – Why? Because God is from everlasting; He has no beginning.

The Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ was 'called' Divine names in prophecy e.g. Isa 9v6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful. Counsellor. The mighty God. The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Now only the Lord God Himself could satisfy the requirement of these names. 'The everlasting Father' – the Son was called that. That was not His name, but that is what He was 'called' - His name is Jesus Christ. 'The mighty God' – the One prophesied to be the Messiah was to be God Himself; God of very God... the mighty God. Micah 5v2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he (Jesus Christ) come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting. (Note in the NIV, which is based upon the same manuscripts as the JW NWT 'bible', it says Jesus came from ancient times i.e. He had a beginning). Human beings DON'T come from 'everlasting' - God does. The JW's and such like, need Jesus Christ to have a beginning so they can say He is not God, hence they corrupt the Bible again to teach their false doctrine. Jesus Christ is eternal and has no beginning. He came to take the body that was prepared for Him (Heb 10v5). John 6v62 What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before? Before? Yes, Jesus was with the Father before He came to earth, because He's from everlasting.

Who is the I AM? - Both God the Father and the Son Jesus Christ are called 'I AM' - Exo 3v14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. Yet in John 8v58 we read... Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

Because of this, the Jews wanted to stone Jesus, for they realised that He equated Himself with God. Note also, Jesus didn't say 'Before Abraham was I 'was', He said 'I am' i.e. He claimed an eternal presence. How could Jesus Christ say that He was the 'I am'...? ...because He is the 'I am' – Jesus Christ is God.

Now here is an interesting piece of information regarding the italicized words in the King James Bible - The *italicized* words in the King James Bible are words that were added by the translators (under the guidance of God of course) to help the reader. This is necessary when translating from one language to another because word meanings and idioms change (*idiom - A mode of expression peculiar to a language; peculiarity of expression or phraseology*). So, to produce a more readable translation, the King

James translators (1604-1611) added certain words to the Bible text. However, to make sure that everyone understood that these words were not in the available manuscripts they set them in *italics*.

On the whole, you cannot translate 'word-for-word' from one language to another without adding or subtracting words. The KJV Bible shows you all the added words that were not in the 'originals'. No other Bible versions do this e.g. NKJV, NIV, ESV, RSV, NWT. They are all dishonest 'bibles' and cannot be trusted. You can't tell what was in the original and what wasn't. The King James Bible is the only Bible to do this and shows the honesty and integrity of the translation.

Now look at the following Scriptures from the Book of John, and see what Jesus says about Himself... note the 'he' in italics (i.e. not in the originals) John 8v24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that Lam he, ye shall die in your sins. John 8v28 Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that Lam he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things. John 9v9 Some said, This is he: others said, He is like him: but he said, Lam he. John 13v19 Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that Lam he.

John 18v5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them. John 18v6 As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground. John 18v8 Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he: if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way:

Therefore, Jesus is claiming the 'I AM' title of God, why? Because Jesus Christ is God according to Scripture, not my opinion.

For all of you who enjoy 'Biblical-numerics' note also the term 'I AM he' occurs seven times in the Book of John (the number seven equates to perfection/completion).

Jesus Christ claimed things for Himself that no man could claim, unless He was claiming to be God. He didn't claim to be 'a' truth, He claimed to be 'The' truth; He didn't claim to be 'a' way, He claimed to be 'The' way – now that's quite a statement to make. That means according to Jesus Christ Himself, there is no other way except through Himself. Therefore, Roman Catholicism, Islam or any of the cults, cannot save you, only Jesus Christ can save you from your sins and get you to Heaven. Think about that, for if you do not come through Jesus Christ, you will land up in Hell, no matter what 'other way' you have taken. It's a narrow road, so make sure you are on it. Mat 7v13-15 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. Beware of false prophets, (JW's, Mormons, Roman Catholics, Muslims etc.) which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

The 'First' and the 'Last', the 'Beginning' and the 'End', the 'Alpha' and the 'Omega' - Compare these verses... Isa 44v6, Isa 48v12 with Rev 1v5-17, Rev 2v8, Rev 22v13.

You are to worship God alone – Exo 34v14, Heb 1v6, Luke 4v8. You are not to worship angels – Rev 22v8+9, Rev 19v10, yet in Heb 1v6 the angels worship Jesus Christ. But when people came to worship Jesus, He let them – Mat 2v11, Mat 28v9+10, Mark 5v6, Luke 24v52, John 9v38, Rev 5v11-14. Not once in Scripture do we find the Lord Jesus Christ refusing worship, yet we are told only to worship God, proving yet again that Jesus Christ is God.

Who can forgive sins? Only God can - Mark 2v5 note verse 7...! Jesus Christ is God. Compare these verses... Ps 32v5, Isa 43v16+25, Ps 130v3+4 with Luke 5v20+24, Luke 7v48+49. Jesus Christ can forgive your sins because He is God.

1 John 5v12 He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

John 5v20-24 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will. For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

1 John 2v22+23 Who is a liar (JW's, Mormons, Christadelphians, Muslims, Jews (Acts 18v28, 17v3) etc.) but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. Whosoever denieth the Son (all the cults and false religions), the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

1 John 3v7 ...let no man deceive you...

2 John 1v7 For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

Anyone who claims that Jesus Christ is not God, or that Jesus Christ is the Father is a liar and an antichrist. Beware of these cults, these heretics.

Don't get deceived by these men and organisations; don't get seduced by the JW 'Watchtower' and 'Awake' magazines, they are trying to seduce you into their cult. Beware of the Christadelphians, Unitarians, Jesus Only, and 'Jesus is the Father' cults, they are deceivers, Bible rejectors and Bible 'correctors'... they are liars.

...the truth is in Jesus – Eph 4v21.

How about these verses proving that Jesus Christ is God – Heb 1v8-10.

Who is the Saviour? Compare these verses... Isa 43v3+11, 45v15+21, 49v26, 60v16, Hos 13v4 with Luke 2v11, John 4v42, Phil 3v20, 1 Tim 2v3, 1 Tim 4v10, Titus 1v3+4, Titus 2v10+13. 1 John 4v14.

Who is the 'Holy One?' Compare these verses... 2 Kings 19v22, Ps 89v18, Isa 31v1, Hos 11v9, Hab 1v12 with Mark 1v24, Acts 2v27, Acts 3v14.

God the Father has a wife – Isa 54v5, Jer 3v14, Jer 31v32, and God the Son has a wife – 2 Cor 11v2, Mat 25v10, John 3v29+30, Rev 19v7-9. They are separate 'Persons'.

No one can fully understand God or the Godhead, they are liars if they say they do - Job 11v7 Canst thou by searching find out God? canst thou find out the Almighty unto perfection? Rom 11v33+34 O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? or who hath been his counsellor? Isa 40v18+25 To whom then will ye liken God? or what likeness will ye compare unto him? To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. 1 Cor 2v14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Even though none of us can *fully* understand God, He has given us a book, the King James Bible, so we can read it and get to know Him through it (2 Tim 2v15). Here in this verse, we are told to study and rightly divide the Scriptures, that's how we get to know the Lord and His word.

Let 'us' (One God, three 'Persons')... 'God', in regard to the 'Godhead' – Read Gen 1v26+27, Gen 3v22, Gen 11v7.

If Christ isn't God it would be idolatry to address Him in prayer along with the Father, yet this is exactly what Paul does in 2 Thes 2v16+17; and look at what Stephen says in Acts 7v59+60 calling upon 'God'... and saying 'Lord Jesus'.

It is only God who truly hears and answers our prayers, as Paul explains in 2 Cor 12v7-9, see also 1 Cor 1v2, Rom 10v13, Phil 2v10, Rev 5v12-14.

Only God can raise the dead – Luke 7v14+15, John 11v43+44, John 5v21 – Jesus Christ is God.

God doesn't change – Mal 3v6, James 1v17 cf. Heb 13v8.

John 1v18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him. 1 John 4v12 No man hath seen God at any time.... The Lord said to Moses in Exo 33v20 And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live. Now, Moses talked to God and had a revelation of Him, but he did not see the Lord's face directly. Jesus, who is a real man in the Bible, was God's Son, coming down from Heaven to reveal God the Father to sinners. So, when He spoke to Philip in John 14v7–11 Jesus said that He is

the revelation of God. John 14v7-11 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him. Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. Jesus is not the Father, but Jesus is God in the flesh revealing the Father to the world.

How about these incredible verses... Acts 20v28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he (God i.e. 'Jesus') hath purchased with his own blood. God the Father didn't purchase the church with His own blood, God the Son did. 1 John 5v20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

John 5v23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father (which cults don't do). He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

As believers we know the reality of the Godhead in our lives – Eph 4v6, Col 1v27, 1 Cor 6v19.

Godhead – 'plural' – Acts 17v29, Rom 1v20, Col 2v9, Gen 1v26, Gen 3v22, Gen 11v7, Isa 6v8, Gen 18v1+2.

Godhead in the Old Testament (OT) – Isa 59v19+20, Isa 63v7-10, Isa 60v16, 2 Sam 23v2+3, Isa 48v16.

Godhead Scriptures – Mat 28v19, Mat 3v16+17, 2 Cor 13v14, John 14v16+17, Eph 2v18, 1 Cor 12v4-6, Eph 4v4-6, 1 John 5v7, 1 Pet 1v2, Gal 4v6.

Godhead - one yet separate - 1 John 4v14, John 16v7, John 5v22+27, John 10v30+38, John 15v26, John 14v23+26, John 3v16+35, 2 Pet 1v17+18, John 8v17+18, Luke 10v16, Rev 3v21+22, 1 Cor 6v14.

So, in conclusion... You either believe the Bible or you don't; you can't just choose what bits you agree with, and leave the rest. The cults like the JW's will change 'anything and everything', to suit the teachings of their false organisation: they have written their own corrupt 'bible' translation (2 Cor 2v17, 2 Cor 4v2, Jer 23v36, 2 Pet 3v16) called the 'New World Translation' based upon the most corrupt manuscripts that are known to man. All the cults and false religions attack the Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ; they either reduce Him to a good teacher, a prophet or a lesser 'god.' They are all liars and deceivers – Do not be beguiled by them (2 Cor 11v3).

Take heed to the warning of Peter... 2 Pet 2v1 But there were false prophets (JW's) also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers (Mormons) among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, (Christadelphians, Jesus Only cult) even denying the Lord that bought them, (Unitarians) and bring upon themselves swift destruction. (Roman Catholics).

Read Rev 17 to see the end of Roman Catholicism and read Rev 20v15 to see the final destination of all those who reject Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour (Islam etc.).

If you are in, or have been a member of any cult or false religion, get out now, and stay out. 2 Cor 6v17+18 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Find a church that teaches and preaches from the King James Bible, not some 'bible-perversion' like the NIV, NKJV, ESV etc. Read the Bible, study the Bible, memorise the Bible and live the Bible.

We are living in the very last days before the Lord Jesus Christ returns (called the Rapture) - make sure you are living, serving and working for Him, and whatever you do, reach the lost souls of this world with the Gospel.

If you have read this booklet and you are not a Christian, or not sure whether you are a Christian, you can know that you are saved – 1 John 5v13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that <u>ye may know that ye have eternal life</u>, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. 1 John 5v20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son <u>Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life</u>. (Read also 1 John 4v4, 1 John 5v11, John 3v36).

You must realise that you are a sinner, and it is only the **Lord Jesus Christ** who can forgive you. He died for you, was buried and rose again the third day. He took your sin and died in your place, so you could be made the righteousness of God – 2 Cor 5v21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. 1 John 3v5 And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin. 1 Tim 1v15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

You must also know this, you cannot save yourself, work or earn your salvation (every cult and false religion teaches you have to 'work' to get 'saved') - Eph 2v8+9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. Rom 4v5 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Titus 3v5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his

mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Gal 3v10-14 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith. And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Rom 10v4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth. Gal 3v21-26 Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law. But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

Have you asked the Lord Jesus Christ to forgive you of all your sins? Have you put your faith and trust in Him alone, and His blood atonement for salvation? Col 1v14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Ask the Lord to lead and guide you from this moment on, and start living for Him in everything you do - 1 Cor 10v31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God. Col 3v17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him. Col 3v23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men.

And to finish with... One day you and I shall stand before Jesus Christ and have to give an account of our life to Him. Mat 28v18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. John 5v22+27 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. Acts 17v31 Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead. Don't let the cults and false religions deceive you any longer, turn to the Lord Jesus Christ with all your heart and ask Him to save you before it's too late. It's the best decision you'll ever make, and then you'll know, the true meaning and purpose of life.
